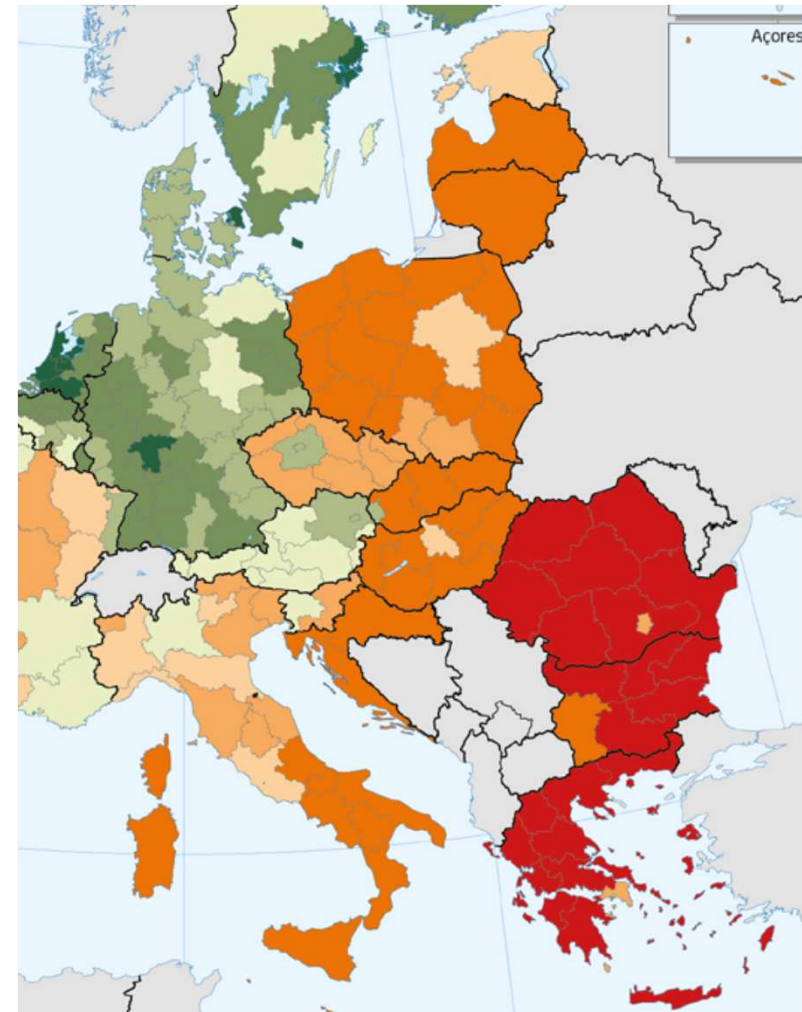
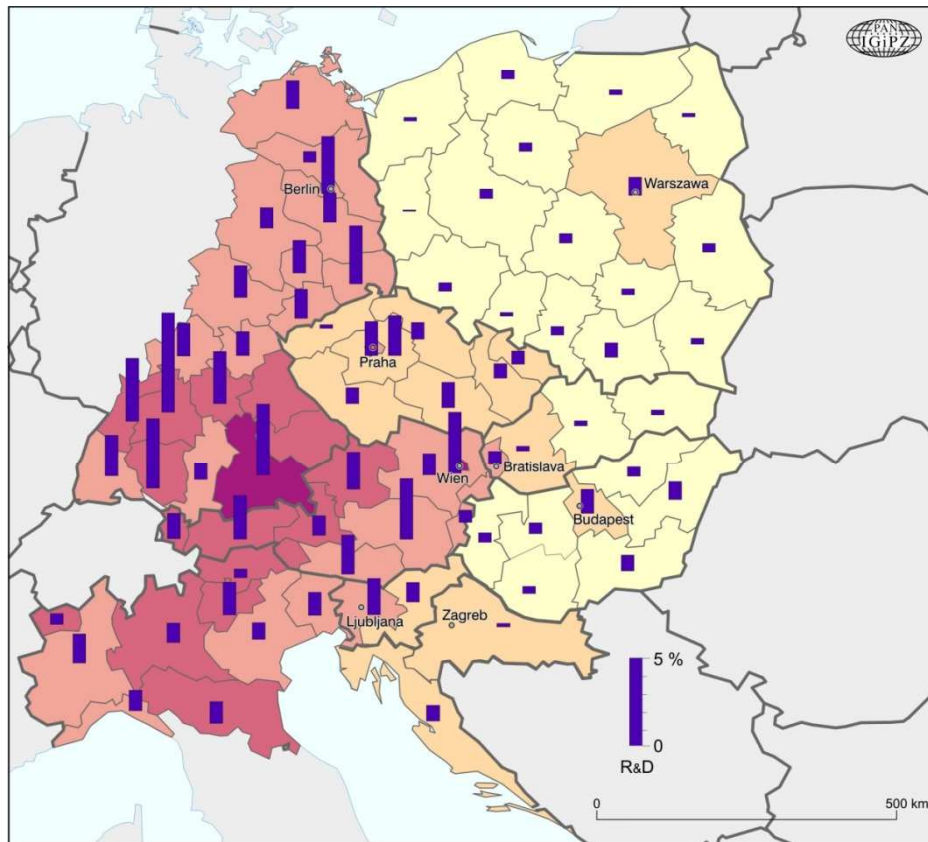

GDP, R&D, Regional Competitiveness

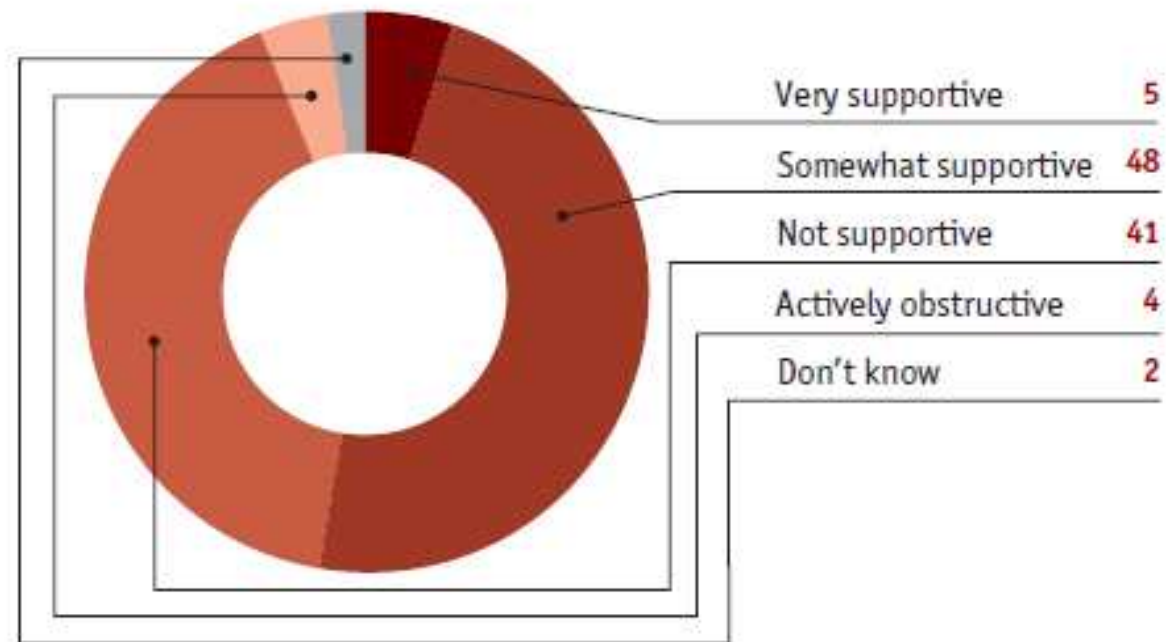

(% respondents)

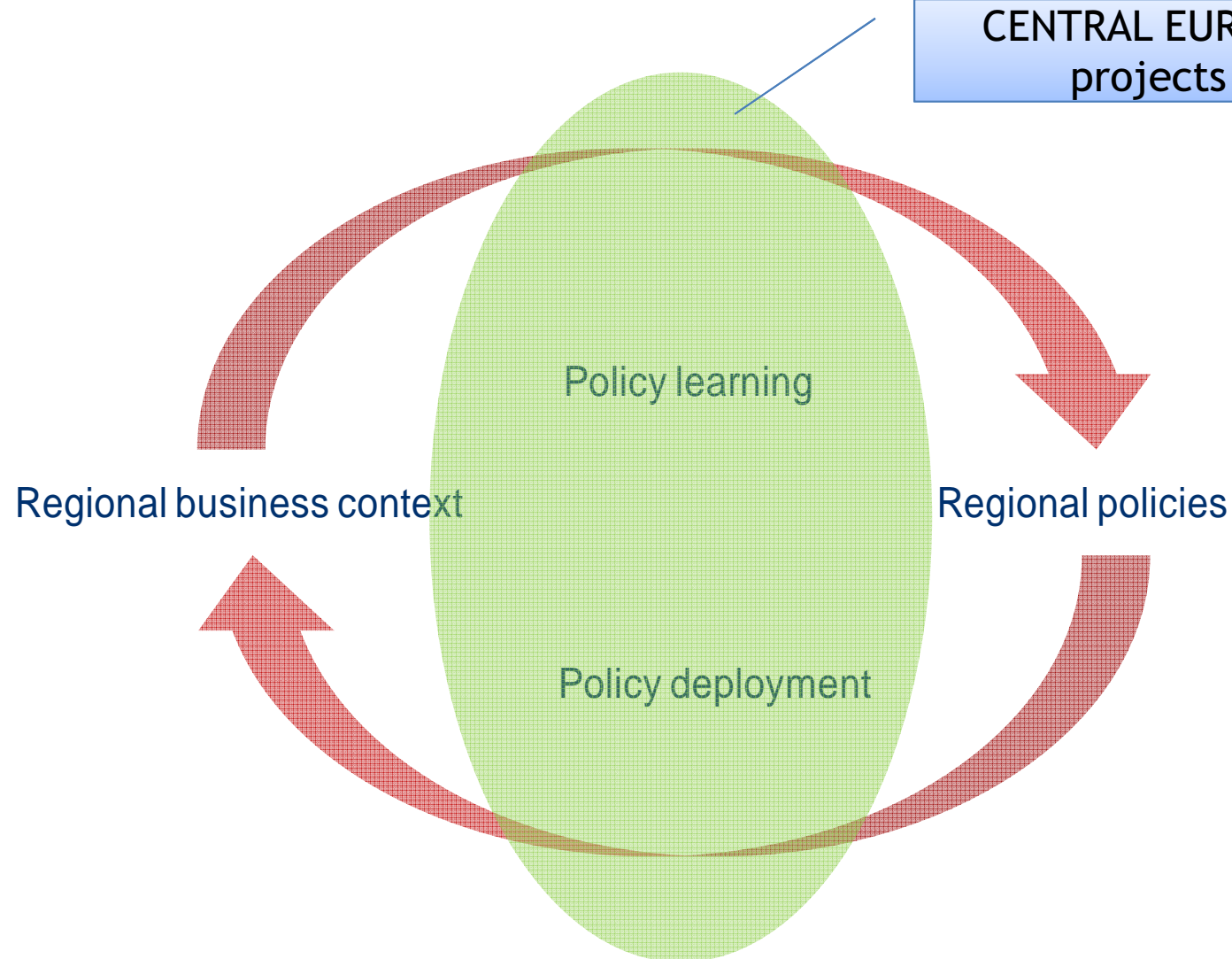
